Challenges for AAL market

- Lack of openness of AAL solutions
- Lack of interoperability standards
- Inflexibility when new user needs arise
- High costs for development, deployment and maintenance
- Uncertainty



The ReAAL project

- CIP-ICT-PSP
- Large-scale roll out of AAL technology on top of open service platform
- universAAL
- Pilots in six countries
 - GE, NL, SP, IT, NO, DE
 - 5000+ users
 - Varied bundle of AAL and eHealth solutions (sensors, cloud, ...)




From ReAAL challenge to OPEA framework


- Will open platforms be able to help achieving market breakthrough?
- **Open Platform Ecosystem Assessment Framework**
- Underlying hypothesis:
 - High quality open platform > benefits for the developer

 - Developers++ and users++ > good conditions for market breakthrough
